PARKING:

Free parking is available in the City Parking Deck at 601 23rd Ave. Enter on 7th Street.

Street parking is limited to 2 hours.

BUSES should load and unload in the bus lane at the museum entrance. Bus parking is available off Jack Warner Parkway, in the parking lot between Synovus Bank and Tuscaloosa River Market, or any other bus parking available nearby.

Buses may not remain in the loading zone.

Remember to get the principal and all teachers to sign the confirmation forms and return within two weeks of receiving paperwork from CHOM. A deposit of \$4 per person is due 4 weeks prior to your trip. Cancellations must be made 4 weeks prior to your trip.
